## Bínder Basics

Students may have one $3^{\prime \prime}$ binder or two $1 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ binders.
If students choose two binders, math, science, and the elective are in one binder, and reading, language arts, and social studies are in the other binder.

## All binders must have the following items in the order listed:

$\checkmark$ The front pocket of the binder designated for homework to and from school
$\checkmark$ A pencil pouch in the front of the binder that includes:
[] Four or more sharpened pencils
[] Two or more pens
[] Two highlighters
[] Post-It Notes
[] Flash drive (if needed)
[6 Calculator (if needed)
$\checkmark$ The student agenda filled out every day for every class. (Each day, part of the student's homework should include at least one step of the note-taking process: study, process, connect to, reflect, revise, and apply the information from class notes.)
$\checkmark$ Notebook paper
$\checkmark$ A divider tab for each subject
[ Under each individual subject tab, the teacher designates what tabs should be included
[3. All subject sections should have a section for notes
